Benefits of the Scholar Program

The CAP Scholar Program is designed to recognize COHEAO members who have advanced their knowledge and professional growth in the higher education areas related to student financial services through participation in COHEAO-sponsored events. Candidates for the CAP Scholar Program will have previously completed all requirements of the CAP Certification Program.

- Recognition in the COHEAO newsletter and on the website.
- CAP Scholar Certificate presented at the annual conference following achievement.

Criteria for CAP Scholar

Candidates for the CAP Scholar Program will have previously completed all requirements of the CAP Certification Program. Scholars must achieve a minimum of 44 points to be eligible following the same Certification points system.

Points will be earned as follows:

- Attending COHEAO Annual Conference. (2 points)
- Attending COHEAO Regional Workshop. (2 points)
- Attending COHEAO teleconference/webinar/seminar. (1 point per each attendance)
- Attending COHEAO teleconference/webinar/seminar as a guest. (1 point per each attendance)
- Completion of COHEAO Summer Institute. (2 points)
- Participation during a COHEAO sponsored Congressional Hill visit or visiting a local delegation office. (1 point)
- Presenting at a COHEAO Conference or on behalf of COHEAO at another conference. (1 point)

Additionally, Scholars will receive:

- 4 points for participation as an active member of a COHEAO Task Force or COHEAO Board member. (maximum of 4 points for this category)
